Joseph Goebbels: The Man Behind Hitler Senior Group Website

After watching the German-based film *Der Untergang* about the last few months of Nazi Germany's existence before capitulation, we both became extremely interested in a particularly short man that reeked of death. He stood behind Adolf Hitler in the *Fuhrer-bunker* at all times listening to his rants, decisions, and carrying out tasks assigned to him. By the end of the film, this strange-looking man poisoned his children, shot his wife, soaked them all including himself in gasoline, shot himself, and had an SS soldier burn them all. This man, upon further research, was Joseph Goebbels head of the Reich Ministry of Propaganda. Learning about NHD's new annual theme based on communications, we realized propaganda is a form of communication and so were the mediums used to distribute it.

Starting off, we researched the broader themes of our topic to gain a general understanding of Nazi Propaganda and its mediums of distribution. As we researched deeper, we began gathering information from websites, virtual museum exhibits, books, newspapers, and more.
